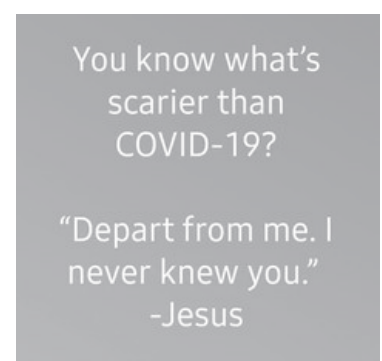
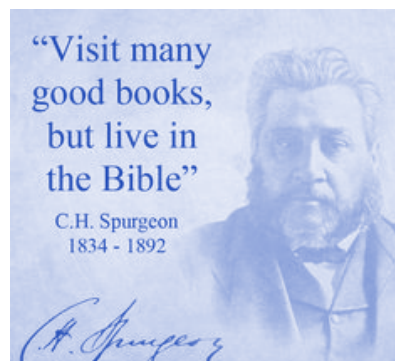

**Mission Support Group News:** **The Mission to Seafarers Geelong** has had a remarkable ministry since the beginning of the pandemic. The chaplain, Rev. Noah Park, and his wife Lydia, have made hundreds of deliveries of all sorts of goods to ships coming into the Geelong port.

A system was developed where ships would send in a "shopping list" to their shipping agent, who would pass it on to Noah. He and Lydia would then go and buy the goods listed and have them ready to drop at the gangway to the ship when it arrived. The list could include everything from groceries, clothing and shoes, to items from chemists and sporting goods.

In his report to the last Committee meeting, Noah reported how a captain had contacted him and told him he had to buy 26 new chairs for the crew, to replace the ones on the ship. He said "what am I going to do?" So, Noah and Lydia scoured the furniture shops of Geelong, bought 26, loaded them in the mission's bus, and delivered them to the ship.

While all this was happening, Noah continued to send out electronically, weekly services and sermons to ships around the world.

Now that some seafarers are allowed off their ships again, Noah is picking them up from their ships and driving them to the mission or on shopping expeditions.

Please pray for this wonderful ministry, and for continues energy and wisdom for Noah and Lydia as they give themselves tirelessly to this special mission.
