## Mission news

**CMS (Church Missionary Society)** has developed a new partnership with the Anglican Province of the Indian Ocean, which includes Madagascar, Seychelles and Mauritius.

In the Seychelles there is an emphasis on improving the family fabric. In the past, few couples have married, but that is now changing partly due to the work and example of Abp. James Wong and his wife.

On Madagascar the church has been growing rapidly. This means a shortage of trained church leaders.

Adam and Avril Friend moved there in January this year, and will be teaching at a theological college, and training current church leaders.

The Seychelles suffers from a similar problem of under-prepared church leaders. Ryan Verghese and his family moved there in 2023 to take up a significant opportunity to shape and influence current and future Christian leaders.

Please pray for the Friend and Verghese families as they develop their ministries in the Province of the Indian Ocean.
