MISSION NEWS

Far East Broadcasting Company (FEBC) is Christian radio with a very practical
element to it. These examples are from the Philippines

Example 1: Norudin Abdul, in the Philippines, gained vital agricultural
knowledge and techniques for growing corn and rice from listening to FEBC
Radio Gandingan. The station has played a crucial role in his personal growth
and the development of his community.

Example 2: Baihamera Abas credits Radio Gandingan's programs like Family
Matters, for teaching valuable lessons on education, family unity and moral
values. She says that "these teachings have improved her academic diligence
